Office Memorandum

Sub: Regarding appointment of Registrar by State Pharmacy Councils.

This is in continuation to Council's circular dt.10-12/86-PCI/8344-74 dt.9.9.1997.

It has been observed that some of the State Pharmacy Councils are appointing registrar without any pharmacy qualification and is violating chapter 3 of the Pharmacy Act 1948 .

All the State Pharmacy Councils are directed to appoint Registrar who should be a registered pharmacist with a valid Pharmacist registration. However, the qualification of the registered pharmacist in order of preference shall be as under –

- First Preference – Bachelor of Pharmacy(B. Pharm) from an institution approved u/s 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948.
- Second Preference - Diploma of Pharmacy(D. Pharm) from an institution approved u/s 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948.

This is for strict compliance.
